

## What is HealthHack?



 HealthHack is a 48-hour hackathon aimed at helping medical researchers, health professionals and students to find digital solutions to their problems







## What is HealthHack?


- HealthHack is the Open Knowledge Australia event and it is not for profit, organised by volunteers
- First event organised in Melbourne in 2013 by Maia Sauren, biomedical engineer turned software consultant, inspired by GovHack
- National event in 2016 held in Melbourne (4<sup>th</sup>), Sydney (3<sup>rd</sup>), Brisbane (2<sup>nd</sup>), Perth (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Canberra (1<sup>st</sup>)
- Previous years had independently run local events → changes in the organisation (national lead organisers, introduction of national and local sponsors, etc...)



# Organisation

- Each site has a local team of organisers with a high level of autonomy →
  responsibilities include finding an appropriate venue for the event, problem
  wrangling, advertising and engaging with the community, seeking sponsors,
  etc..
- The event is free for all the participants → relying on sponsor support to cover for the costs of the event (catering, prizes, stationery, venue...) → in-kind or financial contribution
- Organisers & Participants = Volunteers (time donation)

## Health Hack Stages



 Important stages in the hackathon from the start on Friday evening to the end Sunday afternoon/evening:



#### **Idea Pitch**

Friday evening:


Experts are invited to pitch their ideas to hackers (programmers, developers, data scientists, designers, etc)



### **Team formation**

#### Friday evening:

Participants form a team around an idea, based on their skills and interest in the topic (not every presenter ends up with a team...)



## Hacking

#### Sat-Sun:

Each expert
works closely
during the
weekend to find
a satisfying
solution for the
problem in the
given timeframe



### **Final Pitch**

#### **Sunday:**

Teams present their results to the judging panel. Best teams win prizes and eternal glory.



 VizMyGrant (Melbourne, 2014): Easy-to-use "viewing platform" for the NHMRC funding landscape






# Challenges

### Problems presented at HealthHack over the years:

- **Girror** (Melbourne, 2014): Flexible smartphone app platform for research questions that link mood to behavioural decision-making (*gambling mirror*)
- Explore your Genome and Epigenome in an Immersive Virtual Space (Sydney, 2015)
- Antibiotic Usage Data: Assisting clinicians to improve prescribing (Perth, 2015)
- PainPal (Brisbane, 2015): Real-time pain management tool
- MDbox (Brisbane, 2015): Repository and analysis toolkit for molecular dynamics simulations



## Challenges Canberra 2016



- CITeX: Automatically removing citation duplicates with 99.7% accuracy and detecting academic fraud (Best Team Overall)
- Impulse: Using chatbots to make better decisions for your future self or how to stop drinking, smoking and eating too much (Best Commercial Potential)
- TeamX: Simple, accurate, and open source 3D modelling for radiotherapy doctors (Best Design)
- Simplify: Improving the NDIS experience for users, suppliers and the government with a multifaceted marketplace (Spirit of HealthHack)
- SeedID: Automated image processing for biology (counting objects in an image of seeds, bacterial cultures, etc)
- SP4MRI: Applying signal processing techniques to improve MRI


