

- Durability of funding, policy direction and inter-governmental relations
- Flexibility in service delivery
- National goals and consistency in services, regulation and data





### Stakeholder Roundtables EMERGING THEMES

### High-level policy

### Commonwealth Leadership Role

 Working with States to agree standards/benchmarks, goals/targets

### Funding / Purchasing Operational Policy & Delivery

### State responsibility

 States should have responsibility and autonmy to configure service markets according to local needs and prioirties

### Performance Measures & Public Accountability

### Commonwealth Leadership Role

- Shaping KPIs measuring progress towards nationally agreed goals
- Enabling better data collection & sharing





## Feedback from Roundtable Consultations - Health

- Health arrangements generally work well, but gains to be made in efficiency, fairness and coordination of care
- Funding models need to focus on results
- E-health is critical to improve coordination and increase efficiency





# Feedback from Roundtable Consultations - Health (cont.)

- Spill overs across policy areas must be considered
- Greater focus on preventive health required
- System should be patient-centric
